

CITY OF BURTON
SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
MAY 12, 1997
6:00 P.M.

Meeting called to order at 6:00 P.M. by President T. Hammon.

MEMBERS PRESENT: A. Walls; P. Zelenko; T. Hammon, and C. Cross.

MEMBERS ABSENT: B. Centilli, T. Martinbianco, and K. Cox.

OTHERS PRESENT: J. Major, Director DPW; J. Brown, Clerk's Office.

PURPOSE OF MEETING: 1st Public Hearing for a Paving Program.

The President announced that: This is the time fixed for hearing and considering any objections and/or favorable comments to the asphalt paving with open ditch drainage facilities, including associated storm sewer improvements in the following streets, to-wit:

P-97-5 Judd Road - Saginaw Street to Morrison Street

DPW Presentation:

J. Major said that they have signatures from 50% of the residents regarding this paving program. The assessments will be \$1,988 or \$251 for twelve years. It is an Option C paving project. There is a 50/50 chance this paving will be done in 1997, if not, it will be bid in January of 1998 and be done in the summer of 1998. He said they will bid it and let the residents know at the 2nd Public Hearing.

Audience participation:

Joe Hurlburt, 1493 Judd Rd., spoke in favor of the paving, he said the road is bad and needs to be paved. Andrew Green, 4412 Dublin; asked what the cost to him would be. J. Major explained that his buildings on Saginaw have frontage on Judd Road also. The cost will be \$2,385 for double lots and \$1,988 for single lots. Mr. Green asked who paid for the alley frontage. J. Major explained the city would pick up that cost. Carol LaCross, 1515 Judd Rd., spoke in favor of paving and asked about the cost per frontage foot. Helen McCarney, 1521 Webber spoke on maintaining the alley. President Hammon closed audience participation.
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Council Action:

Approve and Authorize Standard Resolution #3 for the Special Assessment Paving District known at P-97-5.

- A. Approve maps, drawings, preliminary plans, and cost estimates as presented.
- B. Determine to construct the proposed improvement as presented.
- C. Order the Department of Public Works/Engineering Division and/or the firm of CHMP, Inc. to prepare final plans, specifications, and take bids.
- D. Order the Assessor to prepare final special assessment roll, with provision that the first payment will become due July 1 1998.

Moved by Zelenko, seconded by Walls to adopt Resolution A (Standard Resolution #3) as read by the Council President. Motion carried 4-0.
