SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
NOVEMBER 5, 1990, 6:30 P.M., COUNCIL CHAMBERS

This Special Meeting was called to order by Council President Cross at 6:30 P.M.

PURPOSE OF THE MEETING: PUBLIC HEARING FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FUNDS FOR 1991.

PRESENTATION:

Mayor Nimcheski advised the Council that we can expect approximately \$116,304.00 in CD monies for 1991. At a later date, the Council must approve projects to be included on the City's 1991 application. She also noted that the fund amount could be reduced at a later date. She read the following into the record:

- Burton Neighborhood Housing Services, Inc.
- South End Water Improvement

Possible other projects:

- Burton Memorial Library Building Improvement
- Street and Sidewalk Improvement
- Senior Citizen Activities (Director Salary)

AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION:

Shirley Hillaker, Executive Director of BNHS, thanked the Mayor, Staff and Council for their past support and asked for their support again this year in whatever way they could. She presented the attached materials to the Council and Mayor.

Loren Frost, 2152 E. Schumacher, said his house had been redone with the help of the BNHS. He asked the Council to support this project.

John Stapish, 5160 E. Atherton, asked if the library listed was the Burton Library at Atherton and Center Rds. He was told yes. He also felt that there were other projects that could benefit more than the BNHS.

COUNCIL DISCUSSION:

Mr. Martinbianco asked if the boundaries could vary for the expenditure of the money. He was advised yes but that new areas would need to be requested and approved at the county level.

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Mr. Smiley asked about the street and sidewalk items. The Mayor indicated that tonight was designed for projects to be read into the record only and the decision to allocate would come later.
