

CITY OF BURTON

JANUARY 11, 1995, 7:00 P.M., COUNCIL CHAMBERS

The Special Meeting was called to order by Keith Cox, President, at 7:05 P.M.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Cox, Cross, Hammon, Martinbianco, Walls and Zelenko.

MEMBERS ABSENT: Abbey.

OTHERS PRESENT: J. Major, DPW Director and W. Walworth, City Clerk.

CHAIR STATES THE PURPOSE OF THE MEETING: First Public Hearing for a Paving Program.

The President announces that: THIS IS THE TIME FIXED FOR HEARING AND CONSIDERING ANY OBJECTIONS AND/OR FAVORABLE COMMENTS TO THE ASPHALT PAVING WITH OPEN DITCH DRAINAGE FACILITIES, INCLUDING ASSOCIATED STORM SEWER IMPROVEMENTS IN THE FOLLOWING STREETS, TO-WIT:

P-94-14 - Glendale Avenue - Lapeer Road to East Court Street South

COUNCIL LISTENS TO OBJECTIONS AND/OR FAVORABLE COMMENTS TO SAID IMPROVEMENTS.

Mr. Major said that the circulator of the petitions was present. (Donald West 1177 Glendale)

Mr. Major said that he hopes the cost can be kept the same by the time the second public hearing is held. He said 60.8% of the residents signed the petitions, which is the Standard Paving Option "C" and the owner must pay for driveway resurfacing.

PRESIDENT DECLARED THE HEARING CLOSED.

Mr. Martinbianco asked if the residents still understand that if they have a driveway in the right of way, that they have to handle the cost of their driveway replacement? He also noted that they will have to pay for the culvert if it has to be replaced. Mr. Martinbianco also asked about the Notice of mailing.

Mr. Major said the mailing is certified by the clerk and that the requirements of the paving are contained in the materials circulated by the petitioner.

Mr. Martinbianco asked that the post office be contacted to see if we can get some type of certification on the mailing.

Mrs. Walls said that she did not want to see any additional costs added to these programs if there is to be any charge by the post office.

Mrs. Zelenko asked if the City files the notices that are returned.

Mr. Major said yes and that he would check with the post office to see if there are any additional ways to handle the mailings. He also said that his office

can put the 5 or 6 items of concern in a more prominent place in the materials circulated by the petitioner.

Mr. Cross noted that it was a 22 ft. road with No Parking signs on both sides.

Mr. Cox asked if the engineering was in house. He was advised yes.

RESOLUTION A: APPROVE AND AUTHORIZE Standard Resolution No. 3 for the Special Assessment Paving District known as P-94-14.

- A. Approve maps, drawings, preliminary plans and cost estimates as presented.
- B. Determine to construct the proposed improvement as presented.
- C. Order the Department of Public Works/Engineering Division and/or the firm of CHMP, Inc. to prepare final plans, specifications and take bids.
- D. Order the Assessor to prepare final special assessment roll, with provision that the first payment will become due July 1, 1995.

Cross moved and Walls supported the following motion:

Approve and authorize Council to adopt Resolution A (Standard Resolution #3) as read by the Clerk. Motion carried 6-0.
