

CITY OF BURTON

FEBRUARY 12, 1996, 7:00 P.M., COUNCIL CHAMBERS

This Special Meeting was called to order by Ted Hammon, President, at 7:15 P.M.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Cox, Cross, Hammon, Martinbianco, Walls and Zelenko.

MEMBERS ABSENT: Abbey.

OTHERS PRESENT: G. Webster, City Clerk.

PURPOSE OF THE MEETING: INTERVIEW ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS APPLICANTS.

PRESENTATION:

The President said there are two permanent board members and two alternates to be selected for the Zoning Board. Four positions are available and five candidates have submitted applications.

AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION:

Larry Stephens, 3049 Vineland, requested that the Council ask the Zoning Board candidates if they, as a board member, would place more weight on individual requests or more weight on zoning ordinances and codes.

Mr. Hammon said they would be able to direct the question to the candidates.

COUNCIL DISCUSSION:

Mr. Hammon asked all the candidates to step into the the hall except Mr. Edmonds, who remained for the first Council interview.

The participants were asked to briefly state why they wanted to be appointed to the Zoning Board and to give a little background information about themselves.

Each candidate was interviewed by various Council members.

COUNCIL DISCUSSION ACTION:

Moved by Martinbianco, seconded by Walls to vote by closed balloting for the top two replacements for permanent Zoning Board members, both expiring on the same

date. This action would require four votes by Council to carry the motion. The remaining individuals could be selected by the choice of the Council either by closed ballot or voice. Motion failed 4-2.

Mr. Hammon suggested they start the vote with each Council member voting for two candidates. The first two candidates receiving four votes would be the permanent Zoning Board members. The balance of the names receiving four votes in succession would be chosen for the two alternate positions.

Moved by Cross, supported by Cox to place the five Zoning Board candidates names in nomination. Motion carried 7-0.

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COUNCIL ACTION:

Council voted to approve the following candidates to fill the Zoning Board positions:

Regular Zoning Board Members:

Terry Parker, 4360 Sunnymead, with his term expiring November 1998.
Motioned carried 5-1.

Lawrence J. Foust, 2163 Briar Lane, with his term expiring November 1998.
Motioned carried 4-2.

Zoning Board Alternates:

William J. Kalanquin, 1198 Carlson Drive, with his term expiring February 1999.
Motioned carried 6-0.

Susan J. Layman, 1079 Arrowhead, with her term expiring February 1999.
Motioned carried 6-0.

Meeting Adjourned at 8:15 P.M.
