

CITY OF BURTON
SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
2ND PUBLIC HEARING
APRIL 9, 1990
7:00 P.M.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Charles Cross, Council President.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Walls, Card, Cross, Hammon, Martinbianco and Abbey.

MEMBERS ABSENT: Smiley

OTHERS PRESENT: J. Major, Assistant DPW Director; D. Lowthian, Assessor and J. Brown, Clerk's Office.

PRESIDENT STATES THE PURPOSE OF THE MEETING:

Public Hearing P-89-4 Wilmar Street and Farmcrest Street Paving District.

The President announces that this is the time fixed for hearing and considering and objections and/or favorable comments to the construction of: Asphalt Paving with Open Ditch Drainage, in the following streets, to wit: Wilmar Street: Davison Road to Farmcrest Street; Farmcrest Street: Covert Road to Wilmar Street.

J. Major gave a brief explanation of the paving project. After bids were taken and the and the costs reviewed the unit cost will be \$3,917.11. Very good bids were received on this project. Curb and gutter will be at the intersection of Davison and Wilmar, Farmcrest and Covert Road and at the corner of Wilmar and Farmcrest. All the drives will be paved, culverts and ditching will be done where necessary, the paving will be normal width, 22' wide and "No Parking" signs will be posted.

Wilmar-Farmcrest will be a bonded project along with Forest, the two projects will have only one bond issue, they will be sold together. He asked Council to act on items A & E only of tonight's agenda. Council may act on the bond issue, Item B, if and when both projects are approved, at the second meeting tonight. Item C, has already been passed, Item D, will be acted upon at the next regular Council meeting of April 16, 1990.

In the audience, Betty Darling, Wilmar Street, asked about curb and gutters.

J. Major explained it would be at the corners.

A representative of Emmanuel United Methodist Church asked about the Church driveway. J. Major explained it would be a commercial type entrance.

H. Walls, 1049 N. Genesee Rd. asked about the Bond sale.

President declared the hearing closed.

Council discussion relative to Items No. A & E only.

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A. RESOLUTION NO. 5:

Resolution that the Council desires to proceed with the making of said improvements and the confirming of Special Assessment Roll. No. P-89-4 and said costs of special assessed against the lands within the respective districts.

E. PHASE III ENGINEERING RESOLUTION:

Resolution authorizing and approving Phase III Engineering for P-89-4
(Supervision of construction and preparation of as-built drawings)

Moved by Abbey, supported by Card to approve Items A & E as written. Roll call showed motion carried 6-0.
