SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
JULY 20, 1992, 7:00 P.M., COUNCIL CHAMBERS

This Special Meeting is called to order by Tom Martinbianco, Chairman at 7:00 P.M.

Members Present: Abbey, Cox, Cross, Hammon, Martinbianco, Walls and Zelenko.

Members Absent: None

Others Present: Mayor, Charles H. Smiley; K. McArdle, City Administrator; J. Major, DPW Director and W. Walworth, City Clerk.

PURPOSE OF THE MEETING: INTERVIEW OF APPLICANTS AND POSSIBLE ACTION OF THE APPOINTMENT TO THE ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS AND OTHER MATTERS THAT MIGHT ARISE.

PRESENTATION:

Mr. Martinbianco asked the Clerk; who had applied as of today. Mr. Walworth indicated Mr. Priest and Mr. Cromwell had applied. Mr. Cox asked if the cut off date was for advertisement or applicants. Mr. Martinbianco said it was to terminate the advertisement. He said that this was the first opportunity for the Council to act due to the schedule of budget hearings and finalizing the budget. Mr. Cox asked if the Council could accept applicants tonight. Mr. Austin said there were no restrictions in State law or City Ordinances controlling Council action in this matter. Mr. Martinbianco asked if anyone was present that wished to apply. Ian Hohloch, 2196 Howe Rd., indicated he would like to be an applicant.

COUNCIL DISCUSSION:

Mr. Hammon suggested that the Mayor and Council consider switching members between the Zoning Board and the Planning Commission when vacancies occur. The Council interviewed the following candidates:

Ian Hohloch 2196 Howe Rd.

Mrs. Walls asked if the appointment would be delayed until the regular meeting. Mr. Martinbianco said that in the past the appointment was made at the Special Meeting. Mr. Abbey said he would like to see a mix on the Zoning Board so that different areas of the City are represented. President Martinbianco thanked all the applicants for their interest in the position. The Council commended Mr. Priest for his years of service to the Zoning Board and the City. Mr. Cross said he was pleased to see that the Council conducted interviews for the ZBA appointment.

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COUNCIL ACTION:

Moved by Cross supported by Hammon to place all three names in nomination.

FIRST BALLOT: Hohloch 3 votes, Cromwell 2 votes and Priest 2 votes

SECOND BALLOT: Hohloch 4 votes, Cromwell 2 votes and Priest 1 vote.

Ian Hohloch will serve as a member of the Zoning Board of Appeals with his term expiring in April 1995.
