SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
NOVEMBER 29, 1993, 7:00 P.M., COUNCIL CHAMBERS

The Special Meeting was called to order by Keith Cox, President at 6:30 P.M.

Members Present: Abbey, Cox, Cross, Hammon, Martinbianco, Walls and Zelenko.

Members Absent: None.

Others Present: J. Major, DPW Director; R. LaDuke, Building Supervisor and W. Walworth, City Clerk.

CHAIR STATES THE PURPOSE OF THE MEETING: 1st Public Hearing for a Paving Program.

The President announces that: THIS IS THE TIME FIXED FOR HEARING AND CONSIDERING ANY OBJECTIONS AND/OR FAVORABLE COMMENTS TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF: ASPHALT PAVING WITH OPEN DITCH DRAINAGE, IN THE FOLLOWING STREETS, TO-WIT:

P-93-11 - McLean Avenue - S. Saginaw Street to Fern Avenue

PRESENTATION:

Mr. Major said the unit cost would be \$1,613.35 with a base lot size of 60 feet. He said there was a 51.5% valid signatures verification. The paving would be 22 feet with No Parking signs on either side of the road. Any new culverts would be charged back to the owner and no driveways would be paved. He said this was an Option "C" paving.

COUNCIL LISTENS TO OBJECTIONS AND/OR FAVORABLE COMMENTS TO SAID IMPROVEMENTS.

Gary Nagy, 2173 McLean, complained about the method of assessment. Mr. Major explained the process. Mr. Nagy thought he should not be charged for the portion of Columbine, as there is no charge for Barnes, which was done with CD monies.

James Skinner, 2113 McLean, said he supported the paving project.

PRESIDENT DECLARED THE HEARING CLOSED.

COUNCIL DISCUSSION:

Mr. Abbey noted that at the second public hearing, the figures will be adjusted for the paving already done on the Barnes street.

Martinbianco moved and Walls supported the following motion:

Resolution A: APPROVE AND AUTHORIZE Standard Resolution No. 3 for the Special Assessment Paving District known as P-93-11.

- A. Approve maps, drawings, preliminary plans and cost estimates as presented.
- B. Determine to construct the proposed improvement as presented.
- C. Order the Department of Public Works/Engineering Division and/or the firm of CHMP, Inc. to prepare final plans, specifications and take bids.
- D. Order the Assessor to prepare final special assessment roll, with provision that the first payment will become due July 1, 1994.

Motion carried 7-0.
