SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
2ND PUBLIC HEARING
MARCH 29, 1993, 8:00 P.M., COUNCIL CHAMBERS

Meeting called to order by Tom Martinbianco, Council President, at 8:17 P.M.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Abbey, Cox, Cross, Hammon, Martinbianco and Walls._

MEMBERS ABSENT: Zelenko.

OTHERS PRESENT: J. Major, DPW Director; D. Lowthian, Assessor; R. LaDuke, Building Supervisor and W. Walworth, City Clerk.

PRESIDENT STATES THE PURPOSE OF THE MEETING: 2nd Public Hearing for a Paving District P-92-3 - Delaney Street Paving District.

The President announces that: THIS IS THE TIME FIXED FOR HEARING AND CONSIDERING ANY OBJECTIONS AND/OR FAVORABLE COMMENTS TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF ASPHALT PAVING WITH OPEN DITCH DRAINAGE, IN THE FOLLOWING STREETS, TO-WIT:

Delaney Street - Davison Road to North Terminus

COUNCIL LISTENS TO OBJECTIONS AND/OR FAVORABLE COMMENTS TO SAID IMPROVEMENTS.

PRESENTATION:

Mr. Martinbianco explained what has transpired to date on the paving project.

Mr. Major said there have been no appeals in this case and the average cost will be \$1,372.08. He said he had a letter from an owner asking that the street be paved.

AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION:

Kenneth Hillier, 2124 Delaney, asked how long the road would hold up. He was advised that some hold up for over 30 years and the City is required to repair for the 12 years of the bond issue.

Gary Card, 2098 Delaney, asked about the ditching of both sides of the road. Mr. Major said that ditching is not automatic and will be done as needed. Any savings would reduce the cost of the project.

Nancy Card, 2098 Delaney, asked about rebates if the project is under the estimate. Mr. LaDuke noted that the County ditching on there street was bad and both sides may need to be done.

A. RESOLUTION NO. 5:

Resolution authorizing the sale of municipal bonds, establishing the bond form, appointing a transfer agent, approving the notice of sale, maturity dates and bond demoninations, etc.

E. PHASE III ENGINEERING RESOLUTION:

Resolution authorizing and approving Phase III Engineering for P-92-3 (Supervision of construction and preparation of as-built drawings).

Moved by Walls, supported by Cross to approve and authorize Resolutions A, B & E as read by the Chair. Motion carried 6-0.
