MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL CITY OF BURTON COUNCIL
MEETING HELD OCTOBER 22, 1979 AT 4303 S.CENTER
ROAD, BURTON, GENESEE COUNTY, MICHIGAN

Meeting was called to order at 8:05 PM. by N. Dombrowski, Council President.

COUNCIL MEMBERS PRESENT: Dombrowski, Card, Mann, Mikulich, Brown.

COUNCIL MEMBERS ABSENT: Dallas.

OTHERS PRESENT: Mayor Wurtz, D. Norris, Personnel Director; M. Martinson, City Clerk.

PURPOSE OF THE MEETING:

Discussion and possible action re/Supervisor's and Police Contracts.

PRESENTATION: D. Norris

The wage increases are a 7% across the board. Any changes are self explanatory in the memos accompanying the contracts.

AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION:

There was no participation.

COUNCIL DISCUSSION:

Councilman Mikulich asked Mr. Norris to explain Section 45 of the SEIU contract. Mr. Norris explained that the Union requested this addition is necessary; to place in the contract rather than assuming that all benefits and increases of the hourly employees would go to the Supervisors also.

Councilman Mikulich questioned as to who were the hourly? Mr. Norris said that those paid X dollars per hour.

Mayor Wurtz stated that this contract affects seven (7) supervisors only, no hourly employees. The supervisors wanted to synchronize their wages and benefits with the hourly employees.

Councilman Brown asked re/Section 31, and the cost of living. Are we prepared in our budgets to adjust such acceleration? Mayor Wurtz stated that Mr. Becker and Mr. Norris have attended seminars re/cost of living and are checking into the possibility of such. We do not offer a cost of living yet. We need to know more about it.

Mr. Norris stated that this is a reopener clause for next year for any possible wage/benefit increases, as this contract is for three (3) years. At this point, we can only anticipate what are employees will ask.

RESOLUTIONS:

1. Moved by Mann, supported by Brown to approve and authorize the two (2) year contract between the City of Burton and SEIU Local 21 M, Supervisory Personnel. Motion carried 5-0 vote.
2. Moved by Mikulich, supported by Card to approve and authorize the transfer of funds of \$9,000.00 from the respective funds to cover supervisor's SEIU contract. Motion carried 5-0 vote.

3. Moved by Mann, supported by Mikulich to approve and authorize the three (3) year contract between the City of Burton and Teamsters Local 214, Police Department.

Councilman Card asked if it is common to have differences in pay for marksmanship, etc.? Mr. Norris explained that it is not common, however, by offering more money for proficiency, we will have better police officers. This additional money is an incentive.

Councilman Mikulich asked if the officers would be practicing during working hours? Mr. Norris said that most of the time, practice would be on their own time. There may be reasons for a cruiser being at the range at times.

Motion carried 5-0 vote.

4. Moved by Brown, supported by Mann to approve and authorize the transfer of funds of \$44,125.00 from the General Fund- Contingency to the Police Fund-Salary and Fringes for negotiated contract. Motion carried 5-0 vote.
