PRESENTATION:

Mr. Kray said the Administration supported this to give our handicapped residents some relief when that may be their only option to install a handicap ramp to their home.

John Miller, 1411 Brady Ave., spoke in support of the proposed handicapped ramp ordinance. He said it was difficult to get a permit. He submitted a plan to DPW. They said it wasn't any good because there was only 48 feet from the center of the road. He was told to apply for a variance that cost \$200.00. He was dealing with a family hardship and the process needed to be simplified.

COUNCIL DISCUSSION:

Mr. Cross felt the ramps should be removed if they are no longer needed. He wanted this stipulation included in the ordinance. The motion passed as written.
