SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

The Mayor announced that the Community Development allocations for the year 2000 would be \$160,000. The administration recommended continuing on going projects of gravel street paving, sidewalks, street ditching, senior citizen's salary, park and recreation, watermain and fire department.

Mr. Major indicated that a packet containing CD history of the last couple of years was distributed to Council.

Larry Petrella, 1081 Howe Rd., suggested a tornado study in the past and it was not done.
