COUNCIL OF THE WHOLE MEETING MINUTES
DECEMBER 19, 2011, 6:00PM, COUNCIL CHAMBERS
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The Council of the Whole Meeting was called to order by Tom Martinbianco at 6:10 PM.

Council President Tom Martinbianco introduced the Public Access Committee chair, Danny Wells.

Mr. Wells thanked State Representative, Charles Smiley and Johnny Burke for attending the meeting. He also thanked all of the service groups who were involved in the Slogan Contest, including Rotary, Kiwanis, Chamber of Commerce, Downtown Development Authority, Eagles, Moose, and VFW.
