PURPOSE OF THE MEETING: DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE RECOMMENDATIONS
CONCERNING THE FOLLOWING:

1. Review of Ordinance Codifications

AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION:

Pauline Dargel, 6119 Hugh St., wanted to know if there was going to be a public hearing at some time during the codification process.

PRESENTATION:

Mr. Austin continued to review, discuss and give further explanation on the codification process. He recommended that the Planning Commission conduct a public hearing on the zoning ordinance amendments. The Planning Commission would make their recommendation to the Council. Then the Council would have two readings, as required, before the ordinances were adopted.

COUNCIL DISCUSSION:

Discussion focused on Ordinance 93-C (The Metro Act) and the application process.

A violation of Ordinance 41-C remained a criminal infraction.

Discussion was held in reference to the BOCA National Fire Prevention Code. This portion was delayed until Mr. Abbey reviewed the National Fire Code to determine if it was in conflict with our current ordinance.

In reference to Ordinance 59-C, the water license application fee was changed to \$100.00 to reflect the current fee schedule.

The next Council Workshop was scheduled for January 11, 2006 at 5:30 p.m.
