1. Review of Ordinance Codifications

AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION:

Pauline Dargel, 6119 Hugh St. wanted to know if there was going to be any public awareness of the ordinances changes.

All meetings dealing with the ordinances will be noticed and the Planning Commission will hold a public hearing in reference to any zoning changes. There will be a first and second reading of the completed codified ordinances at regular council meetings.

PRESENTATION:

Mr. Austin continued to review, discuss and give further explanation on the codification process. He will make any necessary modifications to the codified ordinances.

COUNCIL DISCUSSION:

Discussion was held on the following topics: The International Fire Code, Ordinance 96-C, Ordinance 19-C, Storage in yards and open areas, Parking and storage of campers, travel trailers and boats, Rummage sale permits and Lot split appeal procedures. Rummage sales will be allowed six calendar days free and then a permit is required for an additional six days.

A Council Workshop was scheduled for January 20, 2006 at 3:00 p.m. to continue the review of the ordinance codifications. The review will continue on page 13 of the small black notebook.
