ELECTION COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES
JUNE 27, 2008, 10:30 A.M., COUNCIL CHAMBERS
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The meeting was called to order by Gayle Webster at 10:35 A.M.

Change of poll sites

PRESENTATION:

Mrs. Webster said the 1,7,and 12 Atherton precincts have been relocated to Atherton Middle School, the site is ADA compliant and there's plenty of space in the gym. Precinct 5 was moved from Weston to Emmanuel United Methodist Church.

Mr. Gusie asked for an updated precinct map.

Mr. Bertram asked the number of voters in precinct 5. Mrs. Webster said there are approximately 1,600 voters.

Mrs. Webster said precincts 8 & 9 have been moved to New Testament Community Church to alleviate crowding and because Atherton School has no May elections.

Election Inspector Salaries

PRESENTATION:

Mrs. Webster said the last time the Election Inspectors salary was increased was in 2005. The average salary in the County is \$129, therefore the workers will receive a \$5 a day raise. The base salary will now be \$130 a day.

Continue and establish an Absentee Counting Board

PRESENTATION:

Mrs. Webster said the Absentee Board is very beneficial because instead of sending AV ballots to the polls, they are processed and counted by the Board at City Hall.

Continue and establish and Election Night Receiving Board

PRESENTATION:

Mrs. Webster said the precinct chairmen report to City Hall after the polls close in order to make sure the material is signed before going to the County.

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AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION:

Roneisha Mullen wanted to know the number of Inspectors expected to work in the Primary Election.

Mrs. Webster responded about 100, but we will add about 40 more for the Presidential.
