Mr. Curtis requested Mrs. Foster to provide information concerning amounts owed by Pine Creek, Rizzo Development Park, money outstanding from water and sewer, and monies that came in versus the total outgo for Lapeer Heights.

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS:

Curtis moved and Tinnin seconded the following motion:

1. The Finance Committee's recommendation to approve and authorize the full Council to increase tap-in fees \$1,500 (\$500 water, \$1,000 for sewer), and send the water and sewer projected rate increases to the Council as a whole to be voted on.
