

SEPTEMBER 19, 1990, 10:00 A.M.

This meeting was called to order by Janet Johnston, Davison Township Clerk at 10:10 a.m.

There were 19 units of government represented.

Mrs. Johnston reviewed the Ad-Hoc Committee decisions and recommendations in regards to the By-Laws for the Governmental Clerks of Genesee County, Inc.

Loretta Manwaring questioned Section 3 in reference to removing an officer without cause. Discussion was held in regards to the pros and cons.

Moved by Manwaring, supported by Proffitt to adopt the By-Laws of the Governmental Clerks of Genesee County, Inc., as amended. Motion carried unanimously.

Carol Arvoy said now that the By-laws have been adopted, there needs to be an election of officers.

Moved by Carol Arvoy, supported by Ida Reed to nominate Loretta Manwaring as President until January of 1991. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Jackie Hamilton, Supported by Carol Arvoy to nominate Bill Walworth as Vice-President until January of 1991. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Jackie Hamilton, supported by Arvoy to nominate Martha Lahring as Secretary until January of 1991. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Darene Woodbury, supported by Janet Johnston to nominate Carol Arvoy as Treasurer until January of 1991. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Carol Arvoy, supported by Jackie Hamilton to nominate George Long as Trustee until January of 1991. Motion carried unanimously.

The meeting was turned over to George Long for an overview of the election and discussion of any problems from the August Primary Election. Discussion was held at length and suggestions were given in regards to the processing of the transfer cases when they are received at the County. Mr. Long said he would try to find a solution to the problem. He also stated a telephone has been installed at the Computer Central and he would be certain that all Clerk's would be given this number prior to election.

Mr. Long said the devices should be released by September 22nd and the retention time for this election is 22 months. The County will contact the Clerk's when the AVB's are ready. The last day to register for the General Election is October 9th, due to Columbus Day being the October 8th. Supplies can be picked up on October 15th for the General Election.

A School of Instruction was set up for October 17th at 10:00 a.m., at Grand Blanc Township and the educating panel will consist of Darene Woodbury, Cheryl Ladd, Kathryn Breckenridge and Ida Reed.

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The next Governmental Clerk's of Genesee County Meeting will be held on Wednesday, November 14, 1990 at 10:00 a.m. at Forest Township, Main Street in Otisville. This will be a Salad Potluck Luncheon.
