Guest Speaker: Dr. Rajiv Gupta

He said about a year ago, a speaker was asked to address a group on this topic and we had a large crowd from throughout the community. We had approximately 70-75 people from each sector of the community. From that a group of about 15 was formed as the Steering Committee in the Genesee County area.

There are 150 communities involved in Total Quality Management throughout the United States. The mission of TQM is to improve the economic and social health of the Greater Flint Area and promoting TQM through education.
