

GENESEE COUNTY CLERK'S/TREASURER'S ASSOCIATION MEETING MINUTES
NOVEMBER 6, 1996/12:00 P.M., WEEKDAY'S RESTAURANT

ATTENDANCE: 40

The meeting was called to order at 12:55 P.M. by President Jeff Cyphert.

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Mr. Cyphert announced that Weekdays has a strict policy on the number of people attending the luncheon. They order their food the week before the meeting and it is necessary for us to call in the reservation on the Wednesday previous to the meeting. Because our treasury is so small, we do not have enough money to pay for extra meals when people don't attend the meeting after making reservations. Also, this can work in reverse, whereby we call in the reservation and then more people show up than what reservations were made. Jeff asked for some direction to combat the problem. We have called several places and the price is considerably higher. The only place where there is a buffet bar and a room would be Walli's West and the cost is \$9.50.

Sig explained that the County started billing with the new system on March 1st of this year and each billing has been a challenge. He said they are trying to take the everyone's concerns and suggestions into consideration to make the system more user friendly. Some of the items of concern were posting the payments; meter reads are slow to put in; it takes longer to make name changes; can't use query's; searching information on Tax ID Code; final bills not being bar coded.

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Tom addressed the problems the units are having with communication over the phone lines, printing difficulties and scanning problems.
