

GENESEE COUNTY CLERK'S/TREASURER'S ASSOCIATION MEETING
DECEMBER 6, 1995, 12:00 P.M., CROSSROADS VILLAGE

ATTENDANCE: 59

Mr. Becker called the meeting to order at 1:00 P.M. and he welcomed several guests in the audience.

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Mr. Becker said the MTG will meet on December 14, 1995 at 7:30 P.M.

A brief discussion was held concerning the meeting place for January. It was agreed by all to meet at Crossroads again on January 10, 1996 at 12:00 P.M. The guest speak will be from the Health Department.

Jeff Cyphert said MMTA is creating a fax pyramid for getting information out to Treasurer's. Some of the Treasurer's may have received a letter from me to fax items further down the line. This will enable us to get necessary information out to everyone from the MMTA. Jeff also said he had previously inquired about setting up a workshop for the Treasurer's regarding investments and he received a good response. He said he has tentatively set January 17th from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. at Grand Blanc Township Hall. He said he would be sending notices to everyone as a reminder and would like to receive R.S.V.P.'s. He has contacted an individual from Grand Rapids and Lansing to address the group.

Mr. Becker said Senate Bill 246-249 prohibits elected officials from retirement during their term of office. This Bill should be followed closely.

Doris Carpenter said if this meeting is changed in January from the 3rd to the 10th, then the Treasurer's will also change their meeting from the 2nd to the 9th. She gave a brief report from the Treasurer's Meeting held December 5th at the County Building. They discussed problems with the deferments on the taxes and if anyone needs information on P77718 Report, you can call the County.

Cheryl Azelton said counterfeit bill are being passed through Genesee County. They are in one, fifties and hundreds. A special pen can be purchased through Office Depot to determine if the bills you are receiving are legitimate. If after you mark the bill and it is yellow, the bill is legitimate. If it turns black/brown, it is not.

Guest Speaker: Jim Bassett, Director of Genesee County Parks

Mr. Bassett said on behalf of the Parks and Staff, he would like to thank the Association for meeting at Crossroads. Mr. Bassett gave an update on the Parks and said the Belle is not running this Christmas, as the lake was frozen over before December this year, so the decision was made to take it out of service. Mr. Bassett said at one of the future meetings, he would like to have a few minutes to speak in regards to the upcoming millage campaign. He said they received 6,800 dinner reservations this year and last Saturday and Sunday, they had 1,100 reservations. The attendance is about the same as last year, and the Halloween program is also doing well.

Mr. Bassett said the Warehouse was built so people would have someplace to go and get warm and also get something to eat and drink. However, there was no place to have dinners, so the addition was built. They have done about 15-20 wedding receptions and have had 50-60 weddings in the village. The building is available for rent for various events and we can cater the meal to fit your needs. Alcohol is allowed and this room will hold 300 people for a sit down dinner.

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Mr. Becker said Julie Gust of Standard Federal has brought a gift to be given away, and the Clerk's/Treasurer's Association also has a few gifts to be given away.

Mr. Becker thanked everyone for attending and thanked Mr. Bassett for the tickets that were issued for the Village so everyone would have an opportunity to see the lights.
