LEGISLATIVE SUB-COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES
JULY 8, 1991, 5:30 P.M., COUNCIL CHAMBERS

The Legislative Meeting was called to order by Chairman Smiley at 5:30 P.M.

PURPOSE OF THE MEETING: SWIMMING POOL ORDINANCE; MTA MILLAGE AND OTHER MATTERS
THAT MIGHT ARISE.

PRESENTATION:

SWIMMING POOL ORDINANCE:

Mr. LaDuke said there have been no problems with the ordinance on swimming pools until the recent neighborhood problem. He said it was a good ordinance and saw no reason to change it. It would be costly to revise the ordinance.

MTA:

Mayor Nimcheski said Mr. Foy had advised her that he has not had answers to his letter from the municipalities and he now plans to contact individual municipalities. She said the question that needed to be addressed is if the City would get \$262,000 worth of service from the millage costs. She reminded the committee that the City would also be expected to try to sell the millage and provide resources for the campaign.

Mr. Smiley asked if an above ground pool needed a fence. Mr. LaDuke said no.

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A:

It was suggested that the City might want to wait and see what support is generated in some of the other larger communities before proceeding further.

OTHERS:

Mayor Nimcheski noted that some time in the future the committee might want to consider some type of billing back for fire runs in some instances. She said they might want to consider a special fund for future fire equipment with the monies.

Mr. LaDuke said they have had only 29 weed cuttings vs. 200 last year.

Mr. Smiley noted that he had one complaint on Lapeer Rd.

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS:

SWIMMING POOL ORDINANCE:

The committee wants Mr. Hamilton to review ordinance 44-T and present some new language for consideration to the Council at their next regular meeting. He is to address above ground pools that are less than four feet high requiring a fence and/or above ground pools needing a removal ladder.

MA:

The committee took no action at this time.
