E. ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT

Ms. Warren stated I have given everyone a copy of the proposed budget and we need to have this in by February 1st, 2018. Please let me know as soon as possible if we need to make changes to this.

I ordered 5,000 filled eggs for the Easter Egg Hunt. We may have 1,000 more from last year that can be filled.

The county called me regarding the Iron Bell Trail project. We have until September to spend the grant money. I think we will only have enough to cover the engineering. We need to move on this and the 5-Year Plan.

Jeremy Sharrer would like to join the Parks & Recreation committee. He will be on the agenda for the next council meeting along with Jim Craig for approval of reappointment.

2. 3448 : Glow Parade Event Recap

Ms. Dunsmore said I am very upset about the amount of participants in the parade. The city, fire and county trucks were awesome. If we didn't have them and our police officers, we wouldn't have had a parade. It would have been just us. It was only a 12 minute parade.

Mr. Craig said DDA, Chamber of Commerce and the businesses should especially be involved since we are doing this for the Burton downtown area and businesses.
