ORDINANCE NO. 2018- ____ -153.07(A)

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 153 OF THE CITY OF BURTON CODE OF ORDINANCES BY THE ADDITION OF TEMPORARY SIGN CONDITIONS IN COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL DISTRICTS WITHIN THE CITY OF BURTON AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF

THE CITY OF BURTON ORDAINS:

SECTION I

Chapter 153.07(A)(10) of the Code of ordinances of the City of Burton shall be and is hereby amended as follows:

(10) Unless otherwise approved by the Zoning Board of Appeals, or as outlined below, temporary signs, banners, or inflatable signs shall not be allowed. Temporary signs, banners, or inflatable signs shall be permitted only as follows:

- (a) Only during business hours (or 8-5 or 10-9?);
- (b) Only one sign (or 2, or 3) per business or parcel (whichever is fewer); and
- (c) Sign shall not exceed width, height, etc.

SECTION II

If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of the Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a decision of any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION III

All other provisions of this Chapter shall be and are hereby ratified.

SECTION IV

The violation of the terms of this Ordinance shall be a municipal civil infraction.

SECTION V

This Ordinance, or a synopsis thereof, shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the City of Burton, Genesee County, Michigan, and shall become effective 30 days after publication.

SECTION VI

A copy of this Ordinance may be inspected at the City Hall, 4303 S. Center Road, Burton, Michigan, during regular business hours.
