

CITY OF BURTON
TOWN HALL MEETING
JUNE 23, 1998, 6:00 P.M., SENIOR CITIZENS CENTER

The Meeting was called to order at 6:15 P.M. by Mr. Doug Piggott, Planning Director at Rowe, Inc.

Mayor Smiley made a brief presentation and explained that this is the first of several meetings. The next meeting will be scheduled in September and another in November of this year. He stated it is important for everyone to put together thoughts and ideas of what they would like for the City in the future.

Mr. Piggott said the purpose of the meeting was to provide an opportunity for the public to share their vision of a future in the City. This information would be used in drafting goals and policies for the Master Plan. There were between 70 and 80 people present at the meeting. Mr. Piggott had everyone break into small groups at the tables and each group was to state the top three prouds and sorries of the City. After stating their prouds and sorries, the residents were asked to gather into their group and vision seeing the City in the year 2020 and asked to list everything about the City that please them. After this brainstorming session, they were asked to vote for their top five visions for the future of the City. Each group then presented their top five visions to the entire audience.
